

Course Requirements

12cr in Art Education courses (select 3 from CFA AR 558, AR 551+AR 552, AR 586, AR 565)

12cr in Studio or Liberal Arts Electives

Master's Research Project: CFA AR 890 Becoming a Practitioner-Researcher **OR** CFA AR 892 Arts-Based Research and Practices. Students will determine with their graduate faculty advisor which Research Project course they will take, and plan their second year courses accordingly.

All graduate electives must be at the 500 level or above. They are chosen in consultation with a graduate faculty advisor, based on each student's areas of interest and research. Students must have permission from the instructor and/or complete the course prerequisites.
