Students must earn a **minimum** of 28 course credits with grades no lower than B- in graduate-level coursework per the <u>Bulletin</u> (see <u>Bulletin archives</u> for pre-Fall 2023 curriculum):

- 7 credits minimum per semester (to a maximum of 11.5 credits) for full-time status
- 12 credits of applied lessons (3 credits each of four semesters of study required); students must register for hour-long lessons (CFA ML 5xx odd-numbered courses)
- 4 credits/semesters of MP 608 Chamber Music; students register for the 1 credit 'lecture' and corresponding 0 credit 'lab'. Note: Percussion can substitute MP 670 Orchestral Techniques for chamber music
- 4 credits/semesters of MP 600 Orchestra and/or MP 602 Wind Ensemble. Note: students must register
 for ensembles as assigned in their seating audition, in each of their first four semesters of study,
 regardless if they have earned the required four credits in fewer than four semesters
- 8 credits of electives:
 - Students can choose from grad courses (500 level and above) with SoM prefixes MU, ME and
 MP; academic courses in MH and MT are not permitted for PD students
 - o MET graduate classes in Arts Administration will satisfy elective credits
 - Applied lessons may be taken for up to 4 credits per semester instead of 3. Any additional lesson credit(s) beyond the required 12 would satisfy elective credit in the PD, but no more than 4 credits of extra applied lessons may be applied towards electives. Students must submit a course substitution form to request use of additional lesson credits for elective credit
 - Any additional ensemble credits (MP 600/602) beyond the required 4 will count as electives
- Two solo recitals (each approx. 60 minutes of music). Percussion may substitute 3 mock auditions for one solo recital with Faculty approval
- All students MUST <u>apply to graduate</u> before their final semester of study, complete all degree program
 requirements, and earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 to be awarded a degree per
 CFA Graduation Policy.
