Students must earn a **minimum** of 48 course credits with grades no lower than B- in graduate-level coursework per the <u>Bulletin</u> (see <u>Bulletin archives</u> for pre-Fall 2023 curriculum) and are expected to <u>declare either Dissertation or Recital Track</u> by the beginning of the second year of study. Refer to the <u>Graduate Student Handbook</u> for the full complement of policies and procedures.

- 18 credits of applied lessons, taken over 6 semesters of study. Students must register for hour-long lessons (CFA ML 507 odd-numbered course)
- If a student is required, per the results of the proficiency entrance exams in theory and musicology, to take MT 401 and/or MH 401 review courses (2 credits each), they must take the course(s) their first semester and pass them with at least a B- before advancing to graduate work in these areas. These review courses do not count for graduate academic credit
- 3 credits in music theory courses, MT 600-level or above (for example, MT 601 or 602)
- 6 credits in musicology courses, MH 600-level or above
- CFA MT 701 Doctoral Proseminar: Skills (3 credits) Typically taken in Fall of second year
- CFA MT 702 Doctoral Proseminar: Analysis (3 credits) Typically taken in Spring of second year
- CFA MU 995 Dissertation (3 credits)
- 12 credits of electives:
 - Students can choose from grad courses (500 level and above) with SoM prefixes MU, ME, MP, MH, MT
 - o MET graduate classes in Arts Administration will satisfy elective credits
 - Applied lessons may be taken for up to 4 credits per semester instead of 3. Any additional lesson credit(s) beyond the required 18 would satisfy elective credit, but no more than 5 credits of extra applied lessons may be applied towards electives. Students must submit a <u>course substitution form</u> to request use of additional lesson credits for elective credit
- Students must register for 7 credits minimum to a maximum of 11.5 credits per semester for full-time status
- Students are expected to register for classes on <u>published dates</u> and must register for classes each semester through graduation unless taking an approved <u>leave of absence</u>
- Refer to the <u>Bulletin</u> for the DMA language requirement, recitals, and qualifying exams
 - Students are advised to perform one recital their first year and at least one per year after that
 - Reading proficiency is required in one language, chosen from German, French, and Italian. Students may
 demonstrate proficiency in a foreign language by passing its corresponding reading course at the
 Graduate School of Arts & Sciences: <u>GRS LG 621</u>, <u>GRS LF 621</u>, or <u>GRS LI 621</u>. Students may also satisfy the
 requirement by passing a foreign language examination, administered once each semester by the School
 of Music
- After a student has finished coursework, MU 995, and is completing their dissertation, qualifying exams and/or recitals, they must register for continuing studies MU 996 each semester through graduation, regardless if they are also taking applied lessons
- All students MUST <u>apply to graduate</u> before their final semester of study, complete all degree program
 requirements, and earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 to be awarded a degree per <u>CFA</u>
