Students must earn a **minimum** of 32 course credits with grades no lower than B- in graduate-level coursework per the <u>Bulletin</u> (see <u>Bulletin archives</u> for pre-Fall 2023 curriculum). Refer to the <u>Graduate Student Handbook</u> for the full complement of policies and procedures, including the following general notes:

- If MT 401 (2 credits) theory review is required per the proficiency entrance exam, it does not count towards the degree, must be taken in the first semester and passed with at least a B- before a student can take graduate theory (600+ level)
- Use of electives (4 credits):
 - o Students can choose from grad courses (500 level and above) with SoM prefixes MU, ME, MP, MH, MT
 - o MET graduate classes in Arts Administration will satisfy elective credits
 - Applied lessons may be taken up to 4 credits per semester, with approval of applied faculty. Any additional lesson credit(s) beyond the required 12 will satisfy elective credit, but no more than 2 credits of extra lessons may be applied towards electives. Students must submit a <u>course substitution form</u> to request use of additional lesson credits for elective credit
- Students must register for 7 credits minimum to a maximum of 11.5 credits per semester for full-time status
- Students are expected to register for classes on <u>published dates</u> and must register for classes each semester through graduation unless taking an approved <u>leave of absence</u>
- All students MUST <u>apply to graduate</u> before their final semester of study, complete all degree program
 requirements, and earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 to be awarded a degree per <u>CFA</u>
