CFA AR572 Internship Proposal

Students who have received an offer of a qualifying internship are eligible to be enrolled in CFA AR572 (2 units) upon completion of this proposal form.

Qualifying internship positions should:

- 1) Be related to the student's course of study or career goals
- 2) Include 80-150 hours of work over a span of 6-14 weeks
- 3) Feature mentorship by a supervisor at the internship site and opportunities for a student to develop their professional skills

The student's internship supervisor will work with the student on goals, learning objectives, and deliverables for the position, and will be asked to complete a final evaluation of the student's work.

To receive credit for CFA AR572, students must:

- 1) Complete the initial Internship Proposal form
- 2) Have initial and mid-point check-ins with the CFA AR572 instructor
- 3) Maintain a practice of documenting their work and reflecting on their experiences throughout the course of the internship
- 4) Complete a final presentation reflecting on what they have learned throughout the course of the internship

Students will receive a letter grade based on their final presentation and reflective documentation of their internship experiences.
