REQUIREMENTS:

Students must earn a **minimum** of 28 course units with grades no lower than B- in graduate-level coursework per the [Bulletin](#) (see [Bulletin archives](#) for pre-Fall 2026 curriculum):

- 7 units minimum per semester (to a maximum of 11.5 units) for full-time status
- 12 units of applied lessons (3 units each of four semesters of study required); students must register for hour-long lessons (CFA ML 5xx odd-numbered courses) except when studying with two instructors (register for 2 @ half-hour even-numbered lessons)
- 4 units/semesters of MP 608 Chamber Music; students register for the 1 unit 'lecture' and corresponding 0 unit 'lab'. Note: Percussion can substitute MP 670 Orchestral Techniques for chamber music
- 4 units/semesters of MP 600 Orchestra and/or MP 602 Wind Ensemble. Note: students must register for ensembles as assigned in their seating audition, in each of their first four semesters of study, regardless if they have earned the required four units in fewer than four semesters
- 8 units of electives:
 - Students can choose from grad courses (500 level and above) with SoM prefixes MU, ME and MP; academic courses in MH and MT are not permitted for PD students
 - MET graduate classes in Arts Administration will satisfy elective units
 - Applied lessons may be taken for up to 4 units per semester instead of 3. Any additional lesson units beyond the required 12 would satisfy elective units in the PD, but no more than 4 units of extra applied lessons may be applied towards electives. Students must submit a [course substitution form](#) to request use of additional lesson units for electives
 - Any additional ensemble units (MP 600/602) beyond the required 4 will count as electives
- Two solo recitals (each approx. 60 minutes of music). Percussion may substitute 3 mock auditions for one solo recital with Faculty approval
- All students **MUST** apply to graduate before their final semester of study, complete all degree program requirements, and earn a cumulative grade point average of at least 3.00 to be awarded a degree per [CFA Graduation Policy](#).
