STO-B50— QUICK-START OPERATION INSTRUCTIONS: CRESTRON TPS-6L CONTROL PANEL

- **SELECT A SOURCE TO TURN ON THE MEDIA SYSTEM:**
 - Touch the screen to activate. Choose either the **LECTERN** or **VIDEO** tab along the top of the control panel.
 - LECTERN: Select your input (Laptop VGA/Laptop HDMI, etc.)
 Note: Select Sympodium to use the built-in computer.
 - **VIDEO**: Select DVD or VCR from the menu. Insert DVD or VHS tape into the combo player located in the top of the podium cabinet.
 - Select which projectors to display to (Left, Right or Dual)
 - Screen(s) will lower automatically during 40-second system warm-up
 - If applicable, connect your laptop with one of the cables on the podium *Note: VGA and HDMI cables are located in the drawer in the podium.*
- 3 ADJUST VOLUME & LIGHTING:
 - **VOLUME**: Control volume using arrows on the right of the control panel
 - Be sure that "Mute" is not highlighted

 NOTE: Program Volume controls Computer, VHS & DVD audio. Remember to check the volume on your laptop. Speech Volume controls the podium & wireless lavaliere/handheld microphones.
 - **LIGHTING**: Select LIGHTS on the bottom right of control panel
 - Select the appropriate lighting preset for the media you are using
- **TURN OFF THE SYSTEM AFTER USE:**
 - Press the **SYSTEM OFF** tab on the top right of the control panel
 - When asked, confirm that you want to turn the system off
 - The projection screen(s) will return to the raised position NOTE: During this 2 minute cool down process, system restart cannot occur
