

## **Computer Science Department Placements:**

Post-baccalaureate Academic Fellows provide teaching support for four CS courses (two in the fall and two in the spring). Fellows will teach discussion sections (0.25 course equivalents each), work under the direction of the faculty to mentor and coordinate the activities of the undergraduate members of the teaching team (such as Course Assistants and graders), and perform administrative duties such as maintaining attendance records, assisting with grading, developing plans for discussion sections, proctoring exams, managing online communication platforms like Piazza, etc. PAFs may also have the opportunity to conduct supervised research with CS faculty in their area of interest. Appointments are full-time 9-month positions (Sept. 1 2026 until May 31 2027). PAF compensation for the 2026-2027 academic year is \$45,000 paid over nine months and benefits as described here: <https://www.bu.edu/hr/employee-resources/benefits/>
