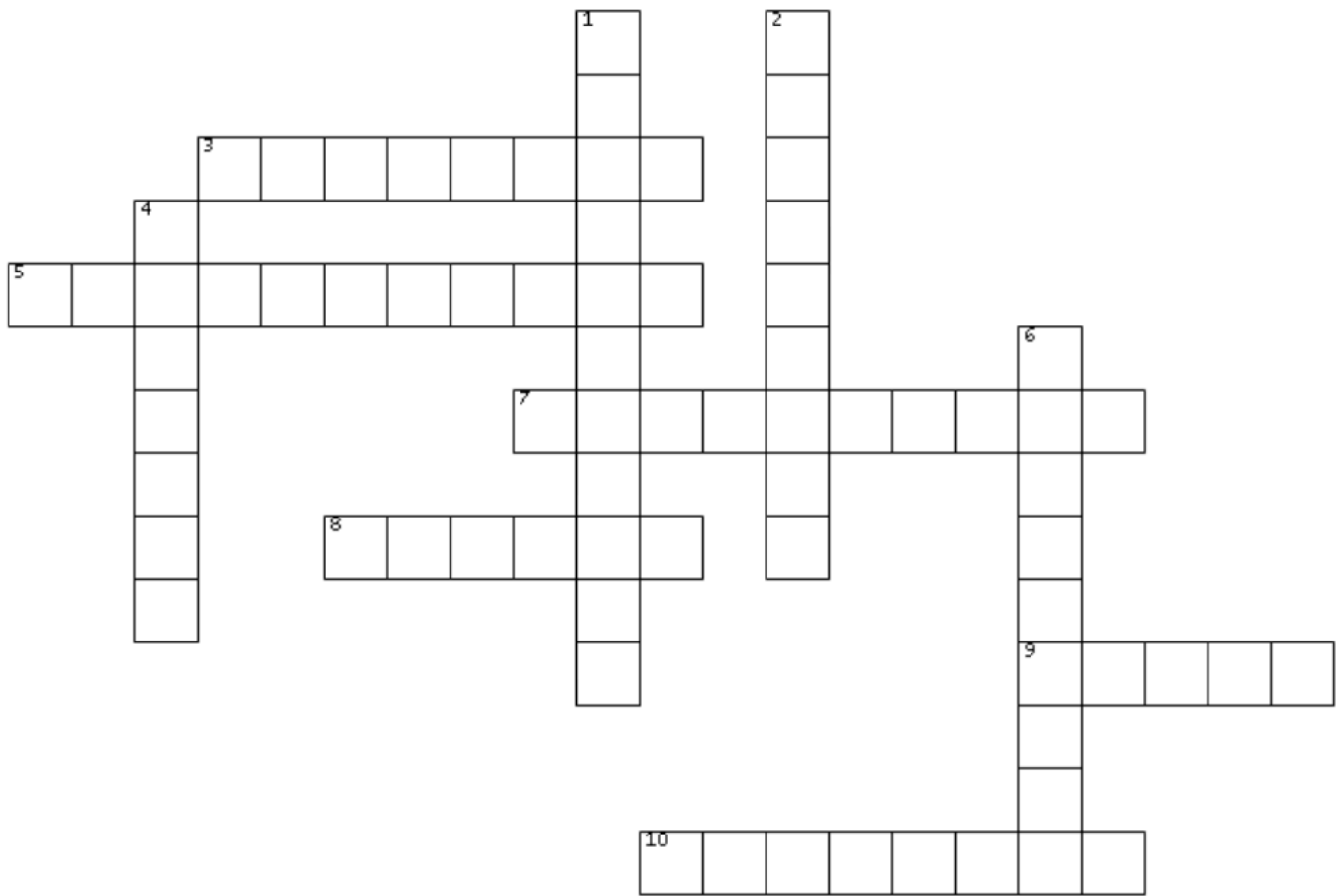


JUNE COGNITIVE KIT CROSSWORD PUZZLE
