

FAQ's for CTSI Integrated Pilot Program Pre Application Process

- 1) Q. Am I required to submit a bio-sketch for all key personnel for the Pre Application?
 - A. No - only the PI's bio-sketch is required at the Pre Application stage. Biosketches and other supporting documents can be added later if you are invited to submit a full application.

- 2) Q. Can I submit more than one application for 2 different proposed projects?
 - A. Yes - you can submit more than one application, however, you will not receive more than one award.

- 3) Q. Can I submit a Pre Application if my proposed research will involve Multiple PI's or Co-PI's, specifically if one of the Co- PI's is from another institution?
 - A. Yes - As long as the PI has a full time faculty appointment at BU.

- 4) Q. Can I submit other supporting documents?
 - A. No - The required documents for the Pre Application are the Abstract and the PI's Biosketch. All other supporting documentation can be added if you are invited to submit a full application.

- 5) Q. I would like to add my References Cited to my Pre Application where do I put them.
 - A. References Cited is not a required document at the Pre Application stage. If you are invited to submit a full application, you can upload the References Cited into the other supporting documents section of the application.

- 6) Q. Can I include figures and graphs as part of my abstract or can they be uploaded into the Pre Application?
 - A. No - Figures and graphs can't be included in your Abstract as this is a text box. If invited to submit a full application, you will be able to upload a document with this information into the Other Supporting Documents section of your application.
