

# Public Health Commitments and Expectations

All faculty, staff, students, and residents have now been assigned to a **COVID testing category**. If you are not sure what category you are in, please contact your manager and/or the Office of the Dean (if you are faculty or staff) or the Student Affairs team (if you are a student or resident).

## Compliance

All members of the GSDM community have a critical role to play in minimizing the spread of COVID-19 within our community. As part of this, compliance with public health requirements established by the state and the university is mandatory.
