- What are the characteristics or skills are needed in your job or industry in order to be successful?
- What are the pros and cons of big companies vs. start ups?

### **Career Exploration by Personal Experience**

- I see you're in X field, how did you get into that?
- Did you always know you wanted to do X?
- Did you try anything different before finding X?
- What advice would you give to someone considering a career in X?
- How did you decide what to do after finishing your degree at BU?
- What was the biggest fork in the road in your career?
- Was there at any time a single decision that you made that helped accelerate your career?
- Were there mistakes you made in your career along the way? What do you know now that you wish you knew then?
- What about your job do you enjoy most? What does your best day or week look like?

### **Grad School**

- I'm considering grad school options, what helped you decide if wanted to pursue a graduate degree?
- How did you decide going/not going to grad school was right for you?
- How did your grad school experience help shape your professional journey?

## **More Conversation Starters**

### Time at BU

- What advice do you wish you had when you were in college?
