

# Undergraduate Research Opportunities Program (UROP)

UROP supports students with funded, faculty-mentored research.

### WHO GETS UROP FUNDING AND WHAT DOES IT COVER?

- Over 70% of requests are approved
- All full-time undergrads including first-year and international students are eligible
- Funding covers stipends, travel, and supplies
- Students applying should be familiar with <u>funding types and stipulations</u>

## **OPTION 1: FACULTY OUTREACH (MOST COMMON)**

UROP encourages students to apply for funding for research experiences not listed on their site. Students can apply to join current research, or even design their own research and find a faculty member to sponsor it.

JOIN EXISTING RESEARCH

- 1. Find faculty and perform outreach
- 2. Secure a research position
- 3. Meet with UROP staff and then apply for funding

DESIGN YOUR OWN RESEARCH

- 1. Develop a research project
- 2. Find a faculty mentor
- 3. Meet with UROP staff and then apply for funding

## **OPTION 2: APPLY DIRECTLY**

Some faculty post opportunities directly with the UROP office. These faculty are usually familiar with the program and can assist in applying for funding.

APPLY DIRECTLY

- 1. Check UROP site regularly for new postings
- 2. Select positions of interest
- 3. Follow posting instructions for contacting faculty
