### Introduce Yourself & Greet Them

Give your full name, smile, offer a handshake, and greet them. Be both friendly and professional.

#### Summarize What You Do

Connect yourself to their company by briefly sharing 2-3 of the most relevant between:

- Your degree program
- An industry interest
- Your current work
- A recent internship
- A relevant club or activity that you are part of

### State What You're Looking For

Concisely mention what brought you to this employer. Are you looking for a specific opportunity or are you just interested in learning more?

### Ask a Question

This is where you start the conversation. Examples of questions you could ask include:

- What does an average day look like for \_\_\_\_ position?
- What do people go on to do after this role?
- I read \_\_\_\_ on the website, can you tell me more about that?
- What is your role at this company?
- Can you tell me more about your work in \_\_\_\_\_?
- Is there anyone you recommend I connect with?

#### Introduce Yourself & Greet Them

Hi, I'm Leslie Winston, it's nice to meet you.

#### **Summarize What You Do**

I'm a biomedical engineering major and I work in the Biomechanics Lab.

#### State What You're Looking For

I'm interested in learning more about the Al Intern position at your robotics lab in Centerville.
