Within the first week of the course, the student and faculty member must establish expectations in written form, including: The requirements of the Honors Project (including length, format, research components, and subject or range of possible subjects) A timeline (including structured deadlines and a schedule of individual meetings) Which assignments the Honors Project will replace in the course and how much it will weigh toward the final course grade 	 If a faculty member agrees to supervise a student's Honors Project as part of a Directed Study (EN 401), that Directed Study can substitute for one of the two additional 500+ English courses. The faculty supervisor of the Directed Study course must be a member of the English department but does NOT need to be the instructor of the additional 500+ English course. Before beginning the Directed Study, the student and faculty member must establish expectations in written form, including: The requirements of the Honors Project (including length, format, research components, and subject) A timeline (including structured deadlines and a schedule of individual meetings) The basis on which the Directed Study course will be graded
