How to Find the IP Address of Your PC

Simply right-click on the My Computer (or This PC) shortcut on the desktop, and then select Properties



Under "Computer name, domain, and workgroup settings", you will find the Full computer name listed.

Once you have your Full computer Name, email it to yourself for future reference.

Don't forget to add :513 (colon 513) after the Name for remote login access.
