Verse submissions should be approximately **100 lines** of a single long poem or several shorter works by the same poet or poets of similar style and period. **Fiction or drama submissions** should not exceed **12 double-spaced pages** and may be a complete short work or an excerpt (chapter, act, or section) of a longer work. You may include a one-paragraph contextual statement in your submission (optional).
