Verse submissions should not exceed **100 lines** of a single long poem or several shorter works by the same poet or by poets of similar style and period.

Prose submissionsin fiction or drama should not exceed **12 double-spaced pages** of a complete work or excerpt (chapter, act, or section) of a longer work.
