Only 0.5% of BU borrowers default on their federal loans after three years, compared to the national average of 2.3%.

DEMOGRAPHICS (2021/2022 DATA).

- BU has 17,590 undergraduates from all 50 states and 119 countries.
- First Generation: 3,612
- **Gender:** 58.0% female/42.0% male
- Race/Ethnicity: Asian American: 19.6% African American: 4.1% Hispanic/Latino: 10.8% White: 34.4% International: 22.3% All other: 8.9%
- State of Origin: 27.7% in-state 72.3% out-of-state

Published cost of attendance (tuition, room and board, and fees) is \$76,656 for 2021/2022. But with student aid from BU and government sources, the average BU student pays \$19,575 per year.
