Into the Mystic

The Mystic River Watershed spans 76 square miles across 21 towns, including Medford, Malden, Stoneham, Winchester, Woburn, Arlington, Belmont, and Lexington. Years of development have created pollution and vulnerabilities to dangers posed by climate change—threatening the health of residents, wetlands, and wildlife. A team of Boston University researchers, backed by a \$1.3 million Environmental Protection Agency grant, is gathering geospatial and environmental data as well as community feedback to zero in on areas at risk from strong storms, flooding, extreme heat, and chemical exposures. Their findings will give community organizations the insights they need to design solutions that prioritize the region's most vulnerable residents.
