



Agganis Arena Post Event Cleaning Information Sheet

Each semester, Agganis Arena allows BU Student Groups to conduct paid arena clean-ups after games, concerts, and other events. These clean-ups are a great opportunity to raise funds as a group and require leadership, teamwork, and attention to detail. Groups are allotted a maximum of 5 hours to clean the seating area of the arena and are paid based on the size/scale of the event. The more of your team that participates and the harder you work, the faster your night will go! Below you will find the information necessary to sign up your team.

- **NOTE:** Teams participating in Agganis Arena clean-ups are held to the same high standard that any contracted group should expect. This is not volunteering; it is a job opportunity and should be treated as such. Only teams who have demonstrated satisfactory leadership capabilities will be permitted to register for Agganis Arena clean-up opportunities and performance will affect future appointments.

Steps:

1. Contact your advisor for a current list of available dates and times for Agganis Cleanings. Because dates are being filled on a continual basis, find AT LEAST 2-3 different dates that will work for your team and communicate those to your advisor ASAP.
2. Your advisor will communicate with Agganis Arena management and respond to you when a date has been selected. Please be aware that it is not guaranteed that any group will receive a cleaning in any given semester.
3. Should your group receive a cleaning, one or more members of your team will need to attend a short training meeting with your advisor. This team leader will be in charge of coordinating the clean-up effort on the day of, and will act as the liaison between your team and the Agganis Arena Supervisor.

Once your team is assigned a cleaning, it is your responsibility to ensure the job is done to a satisfactory level. Teams who cancel on a cleaning on short notice or fail to show with the minimum number of people will lose the privilege of requesting future arena cleanings.
