# **Reach History**

The summer outreach dance program began over 25 years ago, when Dance Collective co-founders, Martha Armstrong Gray and Dawn Kramer came up with the idea: bring contemporary dance to children at community centers and camps by creating an intergenerational, multiethnic company. At Micki Taylor-Pinney's urging, Boston University, in collaboration with Mass Movement, "adopted" the program when Dance Collective disbanded.
