

Assistant Coach Position - Boston University Men's Club Soccer

The Boston University Men's Club Soccer team is searching for an Assistant Coach for the 2025-26 school year. We are looking for a coach with a high soccer IQ that can make objective decisions when it comes to managing our roster, substituting players during games, organizing practices, and can help in fostering a hard working yet fun atmosphere for our team.

Expectations:

- Assist in creating lineups for games, conduct in-game substitutions, and setup game planning.
- Run organized practices with a clear plan of drills, set plays, and game-related situations.
- Actively communicate with the team's Executive Board on any team-related matters.
- If you are unable to attend a practice or game communicate that to the team's Executive Board and work with the Head Coach to make sure they are in attendance.

Time Commitment: Part-time position

Fall 2025: Practices begin Monday, September 8th and end Wednesday, December 10th. Will have an estimated 2-3 weeks of games with a possibility of additional scrimmages and regionals or nationals.

Spring 2026: TBD- Practices are Mondays and Wednesdays and typically begin 1st or 2nd week after winter break. Will have an estimated 1-2 weeks of games with a possibility of additional scrimmages and tournaments.

Practices:

- 2 2-2.5 hour practices during the week with official time TBD (one day will be 6:30-9PM and other day 9-11PM).
- Practices will take place on Boston University's Nickerson Field (adjacent to West Campus).

Games:

- Regular season runs from September to mid-October. If the team were to qualify for Regionals and Nationals those would take place late-October and late-November.
- An estimated 10 regular season games. 6 weeks of games (until mid-October)
- Play 8 games against each team in our division and 2 games against non-divisional teams.

- Must be willing to travel either with team or provide own transportation to games.
- Games are against other National Intramural and Recreational Sports Association (NIRSA) college teams in the Eastern and Central MA area, as well as northern RI.

About BU Men's Club Soccer:

The club is one of the most and well-established and successful teams in the Boston University Physical Education, Recreation, and Dance Department (PERD). Last fall season 2024, our team has achieved a significant milestone. For the first time in club history, we attended the NIRSA National Soccer Championships in Round Rock, Texas. We were honored to be one of only 24 teams nationwide to qualify for the Men's Championship Division. Despite giving it our all, we fell short, and are honored to be one of the top 16 club soccer teams in the nation. We are excited to continue our journey this season and are actively searching for the candidate that will spark a difference to our team and help us achieve success!
