Her book manuscript, *State Strategies under Global Rules: Chinese Industrial Policy in the WTO Era*, examines the varying strategies that the Chinese state adopted in response to global trade rules.

She has worked in the public and non-governmental sectors in a range of roles including: global governance and governance innovations research at the Lee Kuan Yew School of Public Policy; international development project management at The Asia Foundation; and international security policymaking in the Singapore Government.
