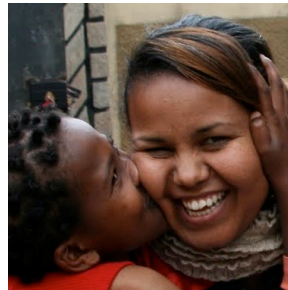
launching a new model: challenges and successes
