Join us for a screening of WINGS' documentary *Blessed Fruit of the Womb* (Charlene Music & Peter Jordan, 26 min.), a story about the fight for reproductive rights and freedom in a country gripped by staggering poverty, the highest fertility rate in Latin America, and one of the highest rates of chronic malnutrition in the world.
