

Summary Annual Report for the Boston University
Travel Accident Plan
(Plan Year ending April 30, 2022)

The following is a summary of the annual report of the Personal and Family Accident Plan, a welfare plan covering accidental death, dismemberment, and total disability (Employer Identification Number 04-2103547) for the period from May 1, 2021 through April 30, 2022. The annual report has been filed with the Internal Revenue Service as required by the Employee Retirement Income Security Act of 1974 (ERISA).

Insurance Information:

The plan has a contract with Hartford Life and Accident to pay certain accidental death, dismemberment, and total disability claims incurred under the terms of the plan. The total premiums paid for the plan year ending April 30, 2019 were \$45,089. In addition, commissions paid to Aon Consulting were \$6,763.
