#### PROJECT-BASED LEARNING AT ITS BEST

Projects are proposed by community partners from many sources including faculty, staff, alumni, entrepreneurs, and non-profits. An interdisciplinary team of approximately 5 students addresses a substantial problem and produces a tangible product (physical object, film, podcast, website, work of art, essay, etc.). 2 faculty members supervise each team to ensure that the 4 Hub requirements are completed throughout the development of the project.

The BU Cross-College Challenge (XCC) is a distinctive one-semester, 4-credit elective course open to juniors and seniors from all undergraduate schools and colleges and a rare opportunity to meet students from across the campus.

XCC offers unique project-based courses in which student teams from across BU's undergraduate colleges tackle real-world problems and develop leadership, teamwork, and communication skills prized by employers. Students from any major collaborate with community partners to explore challenges impacting BU and the City of Boston in areas such as:

- data science
- public health
- racial equity & social justice
- sustainability & climate change
