

Boston Globe Internship Description

The Boston Globe summer intern program began more than 50 years ago as an opportunity for college students interested in journalism to gain practical experience on a major news organization.

The largest group of interns works in Metro as general assignment reporters. Other intern reporters are assigned to Sports, Living/Arts, Health/Science and Business. We also have intern positions in the Photography and Editorial Design departments, and on the News copy desk. Internships are NOT limited to students with journalism majors.

An aptitude for journalism is the most important qualification for the internship. Applicants should be comfortable driving as our interns cover stories from all over New England.

Summer interns work as full-time employees for 12 weeks, between Memorial Day and Labor Day. There are weekly critique sessions for the reporting interns, and lively weekly discussions with editors and staff members on a range of issues and topics pertaining to journalism.
