

## CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

### Pskowski Humanities Junior Faculty Research Fund

The College of Arts & Sciences is pleased to announce the establishment of the **Pskowski Junior Faculty Research Fund in the Humanities**. The Pskowski Humanities Junior Faculty Research Fund has been established through the generous gift of alumnus Harold W. Pskowski, Esq (LAW '84, CAS'71).

Individual awards up to a maximum of **\$2500** are available to tenure-track assistant professors completing a major research project in preparation for tenure review. To be eligible to apply, the faculty member must be a tenure-track professorial faculty member in a humanities department—Classical Studies, English, History of Art and Architecture, Linguistics, Philosophy, Religion, Romance Studies, and World Languages and Literatures. Faculty members under tenure review in AY23-24 are not eligible.

Budget requests for a project can include but are not limited to expenses for research-related travel, access to archives, libraries, databases, and sites, book publication subvention, and facilitation of book manuscript workshops. The fund covers only legitimate research expenses as outlined in the CAS Faculty Handbook.

The Pskowski Fund is not intended for conference travel.

- Project description not exceeding 2 pages in length
- Detailed budget of estimated project costs, including justification for research support beyond available annual research account and startup research account

**The deadline is December 1, 2023; the funding period is January 1 - June 30, 2024.**

*There will be a separate call for applications in Spring 2024 for funding period July 1, 2024 - June 30, 2025. Faculty members under tenure review in AY24-25 will not be eligible.*

Applications will be evaluated by the CAS Dean's Office. Awardees will be contacted no later than **December 20, 2023**.
