



Expectations for Mentoring a Campus Climate Lab Project

All CCL projects are required to have a lead faculty, staff, or graduate student mentor to provide mentoring, feedback, and financial issues.

- In the beginning of a project, the mentor will typically provide feedback to the research team as they plan their project and more deeply identify their research questions and tasks.
- Mentors should touch base with their teams multiple times throughout the semester.
- Mid-semester, the mentor should review progress to date and provide feedback to the team on how they might adjust their plans.
- At semester end, the mentor will review findings and the interim report and should expect to discuss project status with the CCL director and staff (arrange by emailing cclab@bu.edu).
- Project funds are transferred from CCL to the mentor's home department; expenditures for student research hours and supplies should be made through the mentor's home department as well. Unfortunately, no stipend can be provided to mentors.
