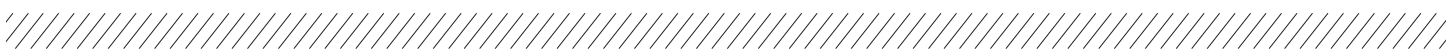




Welcome to the new **BU Law!**

With the reopening of the law tower, **the brand-new law complex is now complete.** This guide will show you where you can find new study spaces, classrooms, courtrooms, key administrative offices, your faculty, and more.



➔ 1ST FLOOR

➔ 3RD FLOOR

- Fineman Law Library
 - On this floor are two reading rooms as well as two training rooms where you can attend library research classes.*

 - This floor hosts most of BU Law's classrooms.*

 - 6 group study rooms are located on this floor, including two that were faculty meeting rooms last year.*



Take Note

- Group study rooms are found on the mezzanine level and floors 2-4
- Classrooms and seminar rooms are located on floors 1, 2, 4, 5, 6, and 7
- There are bathrooms on each floor, with gender-inclusive restrooms located on floors 1, 4, 5, & 13
- With more stairwells throughout the complex, you will spend less time in elevators
- On each floor are water fountains with bottle fillers
- Stations with trash, recycling, and composting options are located throughout the complex
- There is a bike storage room and student showers on the basement level
- The third floor is internal to the Fineman Law Library and is accessible via the stairwell from the 2nd floor library entrance or via the tower elevators
- There is a quiet reading room on the 3rd floor (332)
- The law complex has a variety of spaces for events and lectures, including classrooms, Barristers Hall, McCausland Commons, and the law auditorium
- Faculty offices can be found on floors 12-16
