Go to Profiler > Attorneys & Judges > Search by practice area, city, and/or state. From individual attorney profiles, you can then click on “Organization” to see affiliated firms.

Go to Directories > Attorney Directories > Search by State, practice area, or name.

- ◆ **Bloomberg**
Search for “Law Firm Analytics” > Enter a firm name > Select “View Profile” to get a sense of their clients and cases. Note that this only shows the firm’s litigation work.
