	You will be expected to arrive in Hamburg in time to attend Orientation on September 4- 6. You will likely want to arrive considerably before orientation to secure your housing arrangements (if you have not already done so prior to your arrival). All international students are required to remain in Hamburg through December 22nd due to the exam schedule. The program is divided into two sessions, with a week-long, organized study trip for all exchange students between the sessions. On this trip, students usually visit culturally, historically and politically significant sites in Berlin and Potsdam.
