Application to form an apartment

(Gender neutral/mixed sexes allowed)

All apartments in Los Angeles have the option of being gender-neutral/mixed sexes housing.

A gender- neutral optional housing designation simply means that either a single-gender group or mixed-gender group may select an apartment. The selection of gender-neutral housing optional units will be by student choice only; no student will be assigned to a gender-neutral living situation without his or her express consent.

The following policy and conditions are applicable to students who elect to live in a gender- neutral housing option and reside with a person of a different gender (regardless of sexual orientation, gender identity, or gender expression). By submitting this form all students listed acknowledge that you understand the terms of the policy and conditions and also agree to be bound by them.

- All roommates in gender- neutral housing must at least 18 years of age.
- Applicants must fill the entire apartment to full capacity, i.e., there must be a student occupying every bed in the apartment (see below options for formation)
- · Students must complete the housing form as all other BULA students.
- If any student in the apartment leaves for any reason prior to the start date of the program, the remaining roommates must identify a new roommate to fill the vacancy within a designated time given by the BULA Program office. If another student is not identified within the time period, BULA will assign another student to the vacancy or relocate the remaining resident(s) to another vacancy.
- Like most Universities, BULA discourages students of any sexual orientation who are in a relationship from living together in a residence hall housing unit, although we do not question the student's motives for wanting to live in a gender-neutral housing option.
