Current On-Campus COVID Protocols

- "Back2BU" guide: www.bu.edu/back2bu
 - Specific site for <u>Graduate Students</u>
- COVID-19 testing
 - Required upon arriving on campus. 5 on-campus facilities
 - Results within 24 hours
 - Testing frequency depends on frequency coming to campus
 - Medical intervention & contact tracing for confirmed cases of COVID-19
- Required Symptom reporting when coming to campus
- Required Face Masks
- "Green badge" from Testing/Symptom check required to enter classrooms

- Accept your offer of admission (in Personalized URL or via email). Will receive 'next steps' instructions with curriculum, course registration, & immigration document information within 1-2 business days from your academic department
- INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS: Submit immigration documents:
 - International Student Data Form
 - Authorized financial statement from a bank (original, shown with account holder's name in English)
 - Copy of current I-20 and I-94, both sides (if applicable)
 - Letter of financial support from sponsor (firm, government, parents, etc.)
- Set up your BU Email (Kerberos) Account & register for courses




