



Fall 2021: A return to normalcy...

- Phasing out "Learn from Anywhere" remote modality
- Full return of on-campus courses
- Continued COVID-19 protocols, including:
 - COVID-19 testing (FREE in BU facilities, results within 24 hours)
 - Medical intervention/contact tracing for confirmed cases
 - COVID-19 symptom monitoring
 - Indoor Face Mask requirements in BU Buildings
 - "Green Badge" from testing/symptom check to enter classrooms
- COVID-19 Vaccine Requirement for all students
 - US FDA authorization not required
 - Students may opt for vaccinations in Boston upon arrival (currently available & being supplied for entire BU Community)



What can new MET admits do now?

- Accept your offer of admission & provide required documentation to MET so we can issue your immigration document to begin your visa application
- ➤ Register for full-time coursework (a minimum of 12) credits)
- ▶If you are outside of the US:
 - Follow steps on the visa application guidelines forwarded with I-20 to initiate your visa application
 - ➤ Check the website of the U.S. Embassy or Consulate nearest to you to schedule a visa appointment:

Visa Processing Challenges during COVID

- ➤ US Department of State reports 160 of 223 consular posts processing some nonimmigrant visas with 63 posts closed for emergencies only
- ➤ US Consular posts in China resumed processing in early May
- Processing other posts varies week to week depending on local COVID situation and visa backlogs
- > Required in-person visa appointment waived temporarily for some visa renewals versus first time visa applicants
- > Students should continue to follow instructions from their specific consular posts and advocate for emergency appointments (if possible)

Travel during COVID

- Country-specific COVID restrictions on direct travel to the US within 14 days from Brazil, China, India, Iran, Ireland, South Africa, UK & 26 Schengen countries remain in place
 - Students with valid F-1 visas automatically National Interest Exemption (NIE) exempt if travelling from 26 Schengen countries, UK, Ireland effective immediately
 - ➤ Students with valid F-1 visas will automatically qualify for National Interest Exemption (NIE) if travelling from Brazil, China, India, Iran South Africa, Ireland & UK only after August 1, 2021 for fall study

Finalize your travel plans

- Make travel plans once you have a valid F-1 student visa
- Fall semester begins on September 2, 2021
- I-20 dates matter new students should pay close attention to Program Start Date and Earliest Admission Date on your I-20 as you can only enter the US a maximum of 30 days in advance and not a day later
- ➤ Be on the lookout for invitation to *First Class* in early July
- Complete Initial ISSO check-in after you arrive in the US

Enrollment Options

- On-Campus Full-Time on a Visa (3-4 courses for Fall semester)
- For some programs, there an option to begin your program EXCLUSIVELY ONLINE (NO Visa provided) for Fall '21
 - Part-Time = 1-2 courses, Full-Time = 3-4 courses
 - Courses are offered in an accelerated pace over 7-weeks (Fall 1 & Fall 2 online terms)
- Defer to a future term
 - Can defer right up until Sept. 2nd
 - Can defer to Spring (Jan), Summer (May), or Fall (Sept) 2022
 - Must complete <u>BU MET Deferral Form</u>
- Program change requests must be made directly to Academic Dept. Program of acceptance must match I-20.
