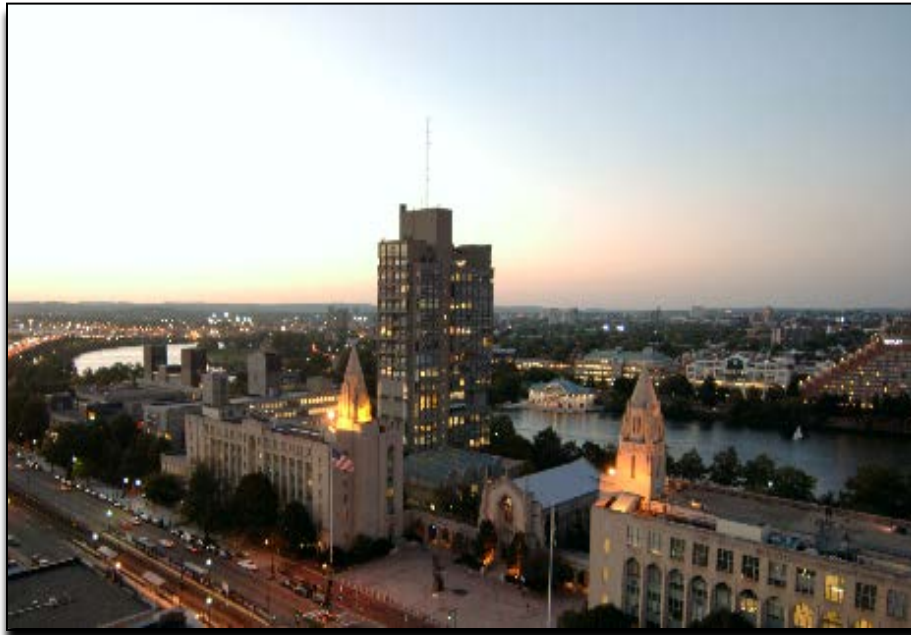

2021-2022 Academic Year Tuition

Student Status	Cost
FULL-TIME: 3-4 courses (12+ credits)	\$29,280 per SEMESTER ** <i>**Summer semesters charged on a per-credit rate</i>
PART-TIME: 1-2 courses (<12 credits)	\$505 (<600 level) or \$940 (600+ level) per CREDIT (4 credit course = \$2,020/\$3,760)

- Must be a full-time student in the Fall & Spring semesters to receive an I-20 for on-campus study
- Summer semester enrollment is optional. Full or Part-time enrollment allowed
- Students may be part-time in their last semester
- Online international students may study from their home country (without a student visa) as a part-time student

2021-2022 Academic Year Tuition

Additional Costs

- **Student Services Fee** (\$184/semester)
 - **Books & Supplies**
 - **Living Expenses**

- To study on an F-1 visa, international students must demonstrate that they are able to fund all tuition, fees, books, and living expenses throughout the duration of their studies
 - Student (or sponsor) must submit financial documentation (required AFTER being offered admission to program)

Total Program Cost Factors:

- **Volume of courses in program:** generally 8-12 courses
 - *Some Computer Science students may have additional pre-requisite courses as part of their graduate program curriculum*
- **Volume of courses each semester:** generally 3-4 courses
- **Summer term enrollment:** Optional as full/part-time student
- Last semester option for part-time enrollment
- Part-time course levels
 - Cost variation for 100-500 level and 600+ level courses
- Note: Curricular Practical Training (CPT) eligibility
 - *AFTER 2 full-time on-campus semesters of study (eligible in 3rd semester)*

Lucy: On-campus, 10 course Master's program
Degree completion: **24 months** (2 years)

Fall 2019	3 courses
Spring 2020	3 courses
Summer 2020	Internship only
Fall 2020	3 courses
Spring 2021	1 course + Internship
Estimated program cost = ~ \$90,000	

Jun: On-campus, 10 course Master's program
Degree completion: **12 months** (1 year)

Summer 2020	4 courses
Fall 2020	4 courses
Spring 2021	2 courses + Internship
Estimated program cost = ~ \$54,000

- Recommend applying *at least* 1 month before start term

(2-3 months for international students)

Professional Portfolio

- Current Resume
- Personal Statement
- Three letters of recommendation**

***It is required that one letter of recommendation be an academic reference if you graduated or engaged in post-graduate education in the past three years.*

Test Scores

- **NO** GRE/GMAT required (optional to submit)
- TOEFL, IELTS, or Duolingo requirement for international students***

****Not required for candidates who have earned a Bachelor's or Master's degree at an institution where the language of instruction was taught in English.*
