Online Program Format

- Recommended part-time taking 1 course / 7-week session (up to 2 courses/semester, up to 6/year)
- 6 sessions per year:
 - Fall 1 (September)
 - Fall 2 (November)
 - Spring 1 (January)
 - Spring 2 (March)
 - Summer 1 (May)
 - Summer 2 (July)
- Courses are asynchronous
- Live Classroom each week
- 15:1 student/facilitator ratio
- Online lectures, videos, interactive animations & simulations, discussion boards, electronic portfolios, web conferencing, etc.

MS in Applied Data Analytics

- 8 courses/32 credits
- Can be completed **online** or **on campus**
- Anywhere from 0-5 **prerequisite** courses
- Ideal for students with a CS or engineering background or relevant industry experience
- Studies focus on the knowledge of analytics tools combined with data mining and machine learning
- Most technical Data Analytics program offered by department

MS in CIS

Data Analytics Concentration

- 10 courses/40 credits
- Can be completed **online** or **on campus**
- Anywhere from 0-1 **prerequisite** courses
- Ideal for students making a career change or pivot
- Designed for students looking to combine technical and managerial competency
- Program prepares students for analysis and documentation of requirements for architecture, design, and implementation of computer application systems and advanced knowledge of data analytics

Data Analytics Graduate Certificate

- 4 courses/16 credits
- Can be completed both **online** or **on campus**
- Anywhere from 0-1 **prerequisite** courses
- Designed for IT professionals and those interested in moving into the analytics field
- Program will explore topics related to data processing, analysis, mining, and visualization
- Students will demonstrate solid knowledge of data analytics practices as well as tools and methods for knowledge discovery
