 - FREE RT-PCR COVID testing in BU testing centers:
 - Schedule appointment thru Healthway Portal, results within 24 hours.
 - All on-campus graduate students are ‘category 1,’
testing upon arrival and once per week thereafter
- [Screening](#)/ ‘self-attestation’ of symptoms each day on campus
- [Contact Tracing](#) for any positive COVID-19 cases within BU
- “Green Badge” to be used to enter BU Classrooms

 - *Copy of current I-20 and I-94, both sides (if applicable)*
 - *Letter of financial support from sponsor (firm, government, parents, etc.)*
- Set up your BU Email (Kerberos) Account & register for courses

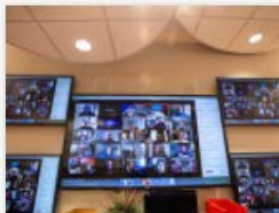
