Online courses

- Part-time enrollment & tuition
 - Up to 2 courses in Fall, Spring & Summer. Generally, 1 course at a time, up to 6/year
 - Sept., Nov., Jan., Mar., May, & July start
- Accelerated 7-week courses
- Asynchronous (no specific class day/time)
- Live Classroom option each week
- Taught by same on campus faculty
- 15:1 student/facilitator ratio
- Interactive learning



On Campus courses

- Part-time & Full-time enrollment & tuition
 - Part-time = 1-2 courses / semester
 - Full-time = 3-4 courses / semester
- 14-week Fall & Spring semesters
 - September & January starts
 - Courses: 1 evening Mon.–Thurs. 6-9pm
- 6-week summer semesters
 - May & July starts
 - Courses: 2 evenings Mon.–Thurs. 6-9pm
- International students must be full-time
 - May be part-time in final semester

- Application Fee (\$85/\$25)
- Pre-Req courses may be recommended within decision (*Computer Science*)
- Decision sent via email within 1-2 weeks

**International students without English instruction at previous institution(s)*

- Open Enrollment completed online
- 2 courses may be transferred into degree or certificate program
- No Federal Financial Aid eligibility

PART-TIME:

1-2 courses

\$955 per CREDIT for 600+ level courses

(4 credit course = \$3,820)

\$520 per CREDIT for 500-level courses
(4 credit course = \$2,080)

FULL-TIME:

3-4 courses

\$30,525 per SEMESTER (Fall/Spring)
