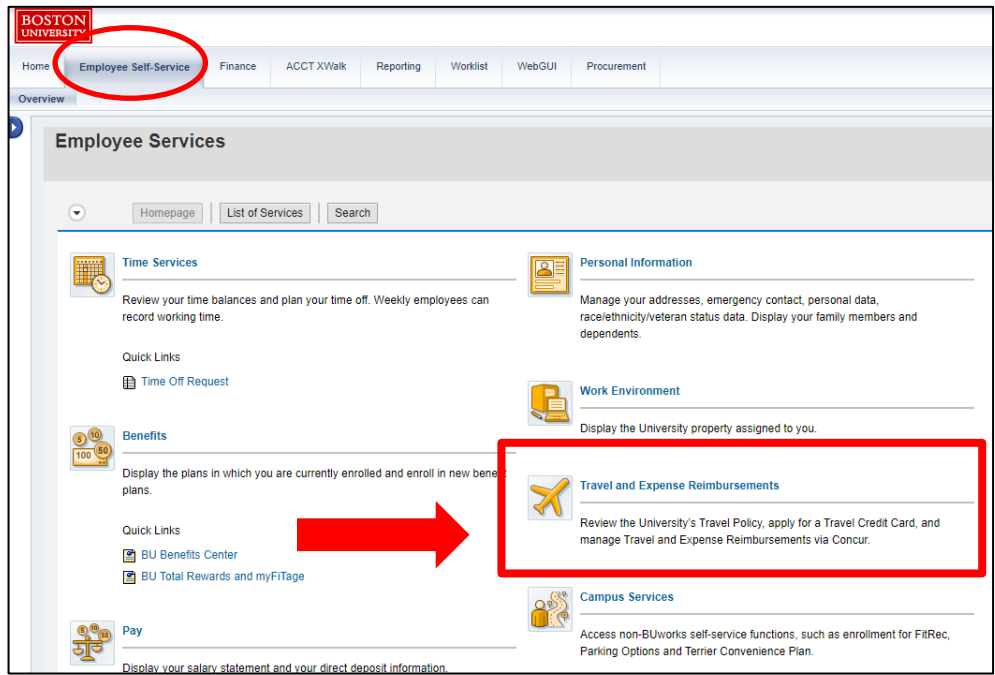
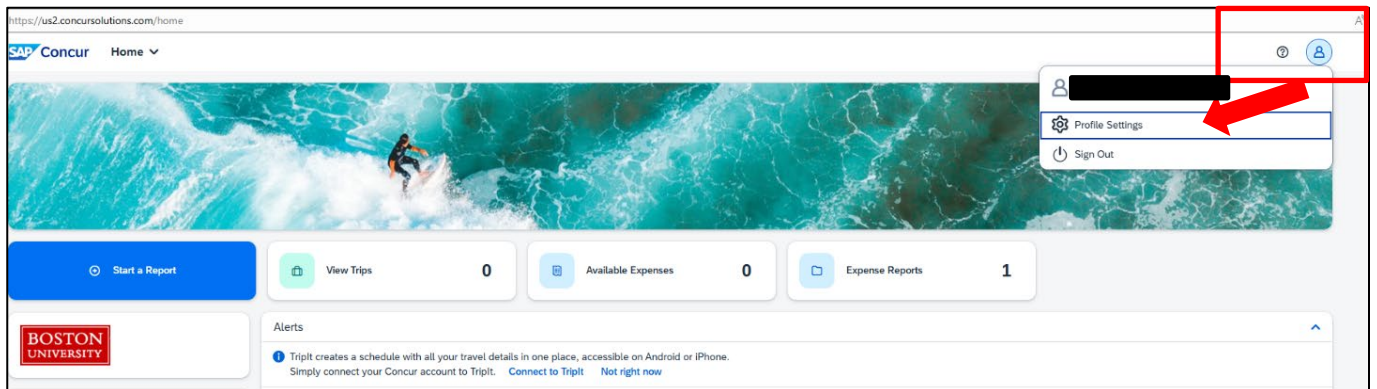


HOW TO REGISTER FOR CONCUR MOBILE

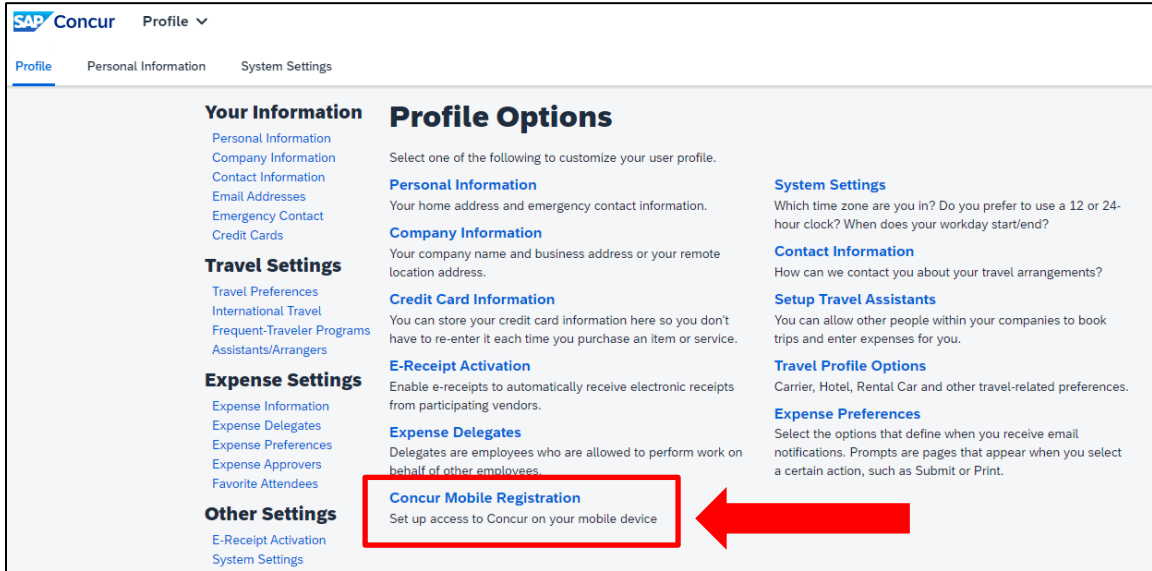
1. Log in to Concur via [BUworks Central Portal](#) and follow these steps: Employee Self-Service → “Travel and Expense Reimbursements” → “Manage Business Travel Agreements and Reimbursements” [Reference: How to Access Concur from BUworks]



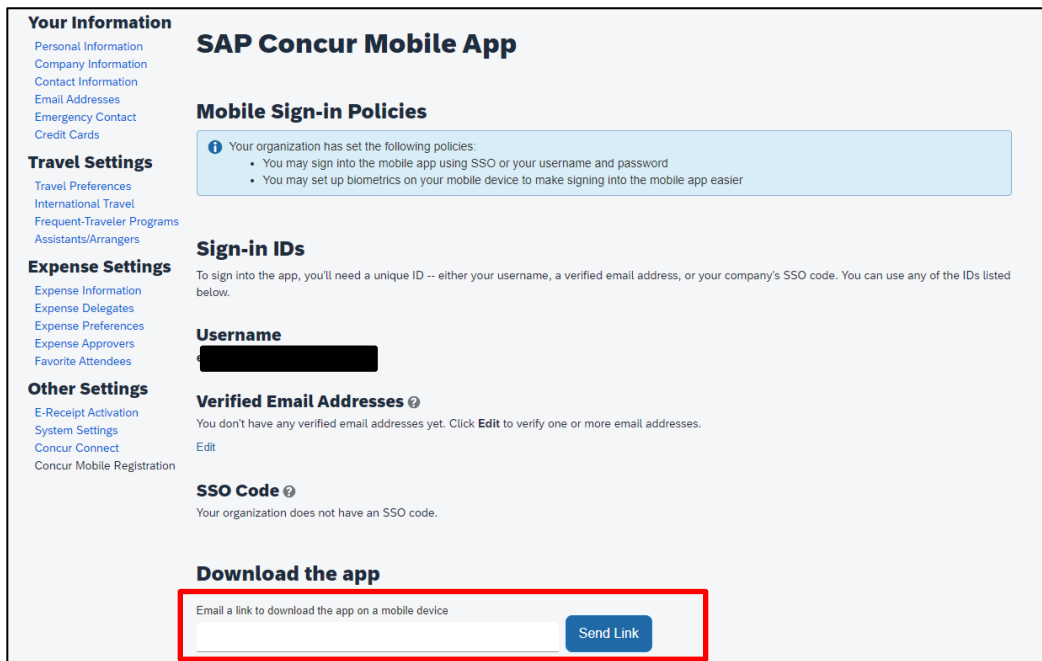
2. Once you have logged into Concur, click the **Profile** icon in the top right corner of the Concur homepage and select **Profile Settings** to display the **Profile Options** page.



3. Click on **Concur Mobile Registration** on the **Profile Options** page.



4. Enter your **email address** to receive a link to download the SAP Concur Mobile app on your mobile device (Apple iOS or Android).



- 5. **Set up PIN** for mobile login. The PIN will be the password used to log into the SAP Concur Mobile app (your BU email address is your username).
