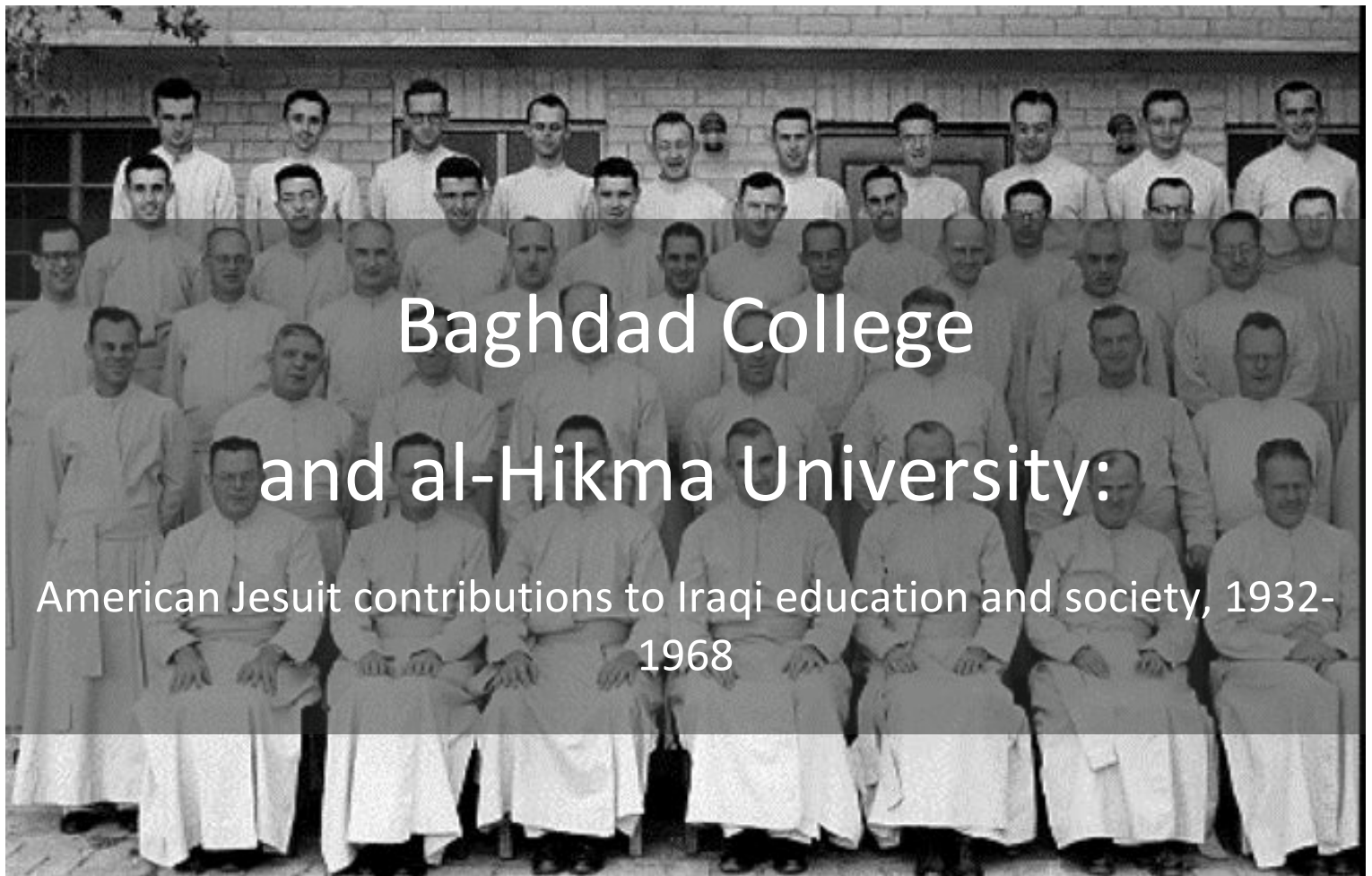

Kristian Girling is a post-doctoral fellow at the Boston College School of Theology. Dr. Girling's research focuses on the work of Catholic religious orders in the Iraqi education system during the twentieth century. He completed his PhD at Heythrop College, University of London in 2016. His doctoral research focused on the modern history of the Chaldean Catholic Church based on fieldwork completed in Iraq and Jordan. He is interested in modern/contemporary Iraq, religious plurality in Mesopotamia-Iraq, and Christian-Muslim relations in the Middle East.
