- Atmosphere of vigorous yearning to eclipse hurtful past, leave the years of the dictatorship behind
 Mainstream belief that there was a price to pay for stability
 Blind acceptance of neoliberalism by the leftist parties
 Abandonment of the ideological rigidity seen prior to the

 - Depoliticization of state and society
 The electoral exclusion of the far left and the pursuit of consensus did have the desired effect of preserving high levels

of order and stability

However, this has resulted in a trade-off with a more representative and responsive form of politics, leading to a disenchantment with political parties and other institutions and a significant decline in political participation

IMPLICATIONS FOR CHILEAN DEMOCRACY

Democratic states allow for citizzens to contest the state within the rule of law, allowing a safety valve upon which citizens can show dissatisfaction or resentment against state policies
