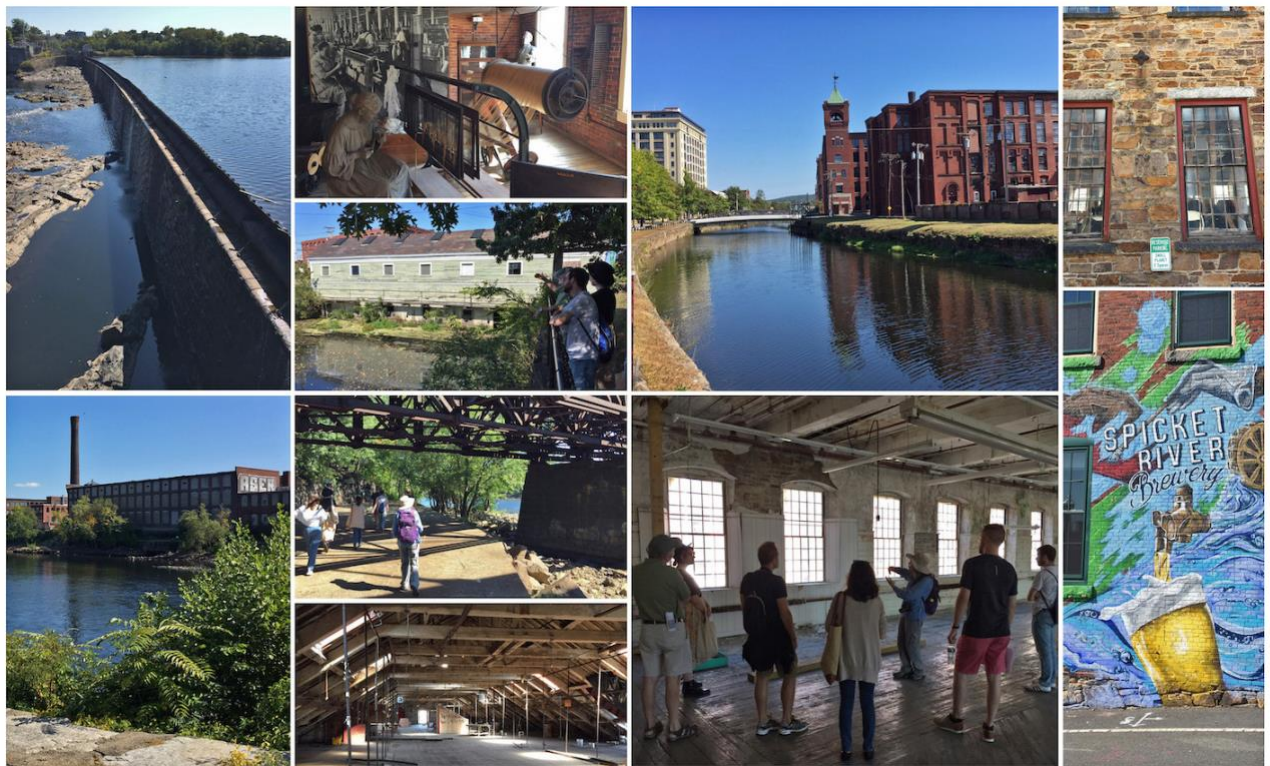


Preservation Studies Field Trip

Field Trip visit to Lawrence hosted and guided by Jim Beauchesne, Visitor Services Supervisor, Lawrence Heritage State Park, with an introduction by Sara Wermiel, BU, on mill construction.

A tour of the Lawrence Heritage State Park Visitor Center and museum, and a guided walking tour in the North Canal mill district: North Canal and the Merrimack River, Washington Mills, Pemberton Mill, Ayer Mill and clock tower (from a distance), Union Crossing (formerly Duck Mill and Kunhardt Mills), Stone Mill, Everett Mill, the sites of Atlantic Mill and the Upper and Lower Pacific Mills, Pemberton Park, and a tour of the Great Stone Dam.
