

Harold C. Case Scholarship

The Harold C. Case Scholarship is offered to outstanding Boston University juniors for their senior year. Case Scholarships recognize scholarly accomplishment and potential as well as extra-curricular activities which contribute to the University.

Award Information

Scholarship recipients receive between \$1,000.00 and full tuition depending on financial need. Funds can only be applied to undergraduate study. Usually, between 10 and 12 recipients are selected.

Eligibility

- Applicant must be a student graduating in 2017
- Applicant must have a GPA of (at least) 3.5
- All nationalities may apply, but applicant must be a US citizen in order to be eligible for award money equaling more than \$1,000

Application Process

Applicant must submit the following items:

- Completed application form (if handwritten, please print legibly) with signature
- Personal statement of 1,500 words (maximum)
- A current Curriculum Vitae (CV)
- An unofficial or student-issued transcript from Boston University, as well as any unofficial or student-issued transcripts from other institutions that granted academic credit
- Applicants can send hard copies of their applications directly to our office at the address below or they may email them to diflynn@bu.edu

Recommendation Letters

The application must include three letters of recommendation from a choice of professors, advisors, employers, or individuals with significant knowledge of the applicant's academic achievement and/or extracurricular involvement:

- The letter must clearly state the name of the scholarship and cannot be applied to any other scholarship for which you may be applying
- Letters of recommendation must have a signature of the recommender
- Recommenders can send hard copies of their signed letters directly to our office at the address below or they may scan and email them to diflynn@bu.edu

Application Deadline

Completed applications and letters of recommendation are due by **Monday 22 February 2016**. Applications received after this date and/or incomplete applications will not be considered.
