

Publication Type	Subtypes	Definition
Book		<p>Includes fiction and nonfiction works, such as scholarly monographs, textbooks, novels, short story/poetry collections, or exhibition catalogs.</p> <p>For edited books, see Edited Volume.</p>
Book Chapter		<p>Writing contributed as a section of an edited book, which may include forewords, prefaces, or introductions.</p> <p>For entries found in edited reference works, such as encyclopedias or dictionaries, or exhibition catalog entries, see Other.</p>
Dataset		Collection of research data.
Scholarly Article		<p>Writing created without payment, for the sake of inquiry and knowledge (as defined by the Budapest Open Access Initiative). Articles are often published in scholarly journals and may or may not be peer-reviewed. For the purposes of My CV, working papers are considered scholarly articles, but articles published as book chapters or in blogs are not. Those are classified as Book Chapter and Other, respectively.</p> <p>For popular articles, such as articles or commentaries that may appear in a newspaper, magazine, or blog; perspective articles or commentaries; letters to the editor; see Other.</p>
Conference Paper (Published)		<p>Papers published in conference proceedings.</p> <p>For papers presented at an academic conference or workshop but NOT published in conference proceedings, posters, or slideshow presentations, see Scholarly Presentation.</p>
Patent		Form of intellectual property that grants a set of rights associated with a product or process to an inventor or assignee, for a limited period of time.
Report		Work that presents the outcomes of research, often commissioned by a funding or sponsoring body. Includes technical reports and white papers.

Software/Code		Software application or source code. Includes apps.
Design		Design created for artistic or architectural purposes. Includes computer-aided design (CAD) files or architectural drawings.
Exhibition		Public presentation or display of a selection of items, in physical or digital form.
Edited Volume		Edited book or journal issue.
Thesis/Dissertation		Work summarizing research findings associated with the completion of an academic degree
Other		May include annotated bibliographies, catalog essays, interviews, popular articles, encyclopedia/dictionary entries, blog posts, perspective pieces or commentaries, and letters to the editor.
Internet Publication		Includes websites, digital projects, or blogs For individual blog posts, See Other.
Media	Audio Recording Audiovisual Recording Image Digital Interactive Work	Media objects, of various forms. May include, but is not limited to, films, podcasts, images, and digital interactive works.
Scholarly Presentation		Papers presented at an academic conference or workshop but NOT published in conference proceedings, posters, and slideshow presentations. For papers published in conference proceedings, see Conference Paper (Published).
Review		Critical analysis of a book, paper, film, exhibition, performance, etc.
Pedagogical Materials		Educational or instructional works, such as syllabi, tutorials, assignments, case studies, assessments, or lesson plans.
Creative Works	Creative Nonfiction	Creative works
