I want to give special thanks to **Associate Provost for Faculty Affairs Maureen O'Rourke** and **Professor of Computer Science Mark Crovella** for agreeing to chair the first two committees.

The membership of the three committees is listed below; I want to thank each of the members for committing their time, energy, and expertise to this important new effort. I have asked the committees to submit their preliminary recommendations to me no later than February 28, 2020.

This is an exciting time at Boston University. The faculty, academic opportunities, and new capacities for innovation we will add through the Faculty for Computing & Data Sciences will greatly enhance our ability to lead in this growing and strategically important area. I look forward to sharing more details with you as the committees complete their work and we enter the next phase of this process.
