The Council also voted during the fall 2020 semester to approve the following degree and certificate programs:

- Master of Fine Arts in Print Media and Photography (CFA)
- Master of Fine Arts in Visual Narrative (CFA)
- Master of Science in Health Informatics name change from Master of Science in Computer Information Systems with a Concentration in Health Informatics (MET)
