SUBJECT:	Scheduling of Final Exams

As we begin a new semester, I would like to remind everyone that, per University policy, the final examination for a course must be given only during its scheduled exam period and time slot and not during a regular class meeting or on a reading day, *even if the faculty member and all students in a course agree to such a change*.

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that our students have the appropriate time and space to prepare for finals during the designated study period.
